YP AWOP MENTOR COVANENT

This covenant was last updated on 03/29/2022

YP Mentors are designed to disciple, guide, and support young Christian professionals. The purpose of this covenant is to thoroughly describe the expectations for being a mentor. The covenant is divided into three categories: (1) personal discipleship, (2) peer discipleship, and (3) ministry expectations. The following highlights our established guidelines...

PERSONAL DISCIPLESHIP – commitment to growing in Christ:

Our top and first priority is commitment to personal growth. Each mentor's spiritual rhythm is listed on the second page of the covenant and maybe subjected to change upon request. A spiritual rhythm focuses on three spiritual disciplines:

- 1) Reading
- 2) Rallying
- 3) Resting

PEER DISCIPLESHIP – commitment to discipling others:

Our second priority is commitment to discipling young professionals. This manifests itself in three ways:

- 1) Frequency of Meeting Every mentor is expected to be willing to meet with their mentee at least once a month for one hour each month.
 - a. NOTE: This may take place in-person or online
- 2) Expectations of Meeting Every mentor is expected to plan out a meeting rhythm with their prospective mentees.
- 3) Number of Mentees No mentor is permitted to be mentoring more than 5 young professionals at a time

MINISTRY EXPECTATIONS – commitment to maintaining collaboration expectations:

We have five main guidelines for group collaboration expectations. They are as follows:

- 1) Adhering to Leadership Every mentor is expected to attend quarterly or semi-annual trainings with the director
- 2) Communication Process Every mentor is expected to communicate with others in the ministry within 48-business hours.
- 3) Length of Commitment Every mentor is expected to be a mentor for at least 6-months after their training.
- 4) Statement of Faith Compliance Every mentor is expected to have read and agreed with our statement of faith.
- 5) Training Process Every mentor is expected to go through the YP AWOP Mentor Training program prior to their agreement starting.
